Oklahoma City, OK — November 2022

In 2022, *Hunt Theory* cofounder Caleb Morrison volunteered as a mentor with the Oklahoma Youth Hunting Program (OYHP), guiding a first-time hunter to their first successful whitetail harvest.

The Oklahoma Youth Hunting Program provides young people ages 10–17 with hands-on training, equipment, and mentorship from experienced hunters. Through this program, participants learn firearm safety, scouting techniques, and ethical hunting practices under close supervision.

Caleb's involvement reflected Hunt Theory's ongoing commitment to education, mentorship, and responsible conservation. His participation offered a chance to give back to the next generation of hunters and demonstrate the core purpose behind Hunt Theory's work: helping others understand and engage with hunting through respect, stewardship, and shared experience.


Partnership Highlights


Our Goal

According to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, about 4.7 percent of Americans aged 16 and older—roughly 11.5 million people nationwide—participate in hunting ("National Survey"). Although participation has declined from previous decades, when rates exceeded 6 percent, states such as Texas and Oklahoma remain strongholds for hunting heritage and wildlife management funding.

Hunt Theory's Goal:

By 2030, help mentor 1,000 new hunters through educational media, community initiatives, and conservation partnerships across Texas and Oklahoma. The project seeks to strengthen hunting's cultural presence while contributing to the conservation programs funded by hunters nationwide.
